The Religion & Belief training programme is now available on an "in-house" basis. The training session provides valuable help and practical support for those wishing to develop greater awareness of religious diversity issues – particularly in the context of The Employment Equality (Religion or Belief) Regulations 2003.

Key Topics

- Belief systems and faith patterns in Great Britain – demographic changes

- Overview of the equality provisions contained in the Employment Equality (Religion or Belief) Regulations 2003 - including direct and indirect discrimination, victimisation and harassment.
- Applying the regulations - the legal requirements.
- Practical considerations e.g. food, holidays, dress, prayer etc.
- Recognising the needs of different faiths in the workplace - how are we doing?
- Building good relations with people of different faiths and beliefs - our role in religious diversity
- Creativity in religion and belief – case study
- Action plan

This is an important course for all staff especially those in managerial or supervisory positions. It is particularly relevant for all human resource personnel – including those with responsibilities in training, equality or diversity.
